

Land of Lincoln Planning and Zoning Commission

12 April 2012 Meeting Minutes

The Land of Lincoln Planning and Zoning Commission was called to order on Thursday, 12 April 2012, by Paul Lassanske, Chairman.

Roll was called and the following Commission members were present for the hearing: Paul Lassanske, Robert Enlow, Harold Skaggs, Rick Roach, Steve Payne, and Wayne Trombley.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

Payment of Bills: Harold Skaggs made a motion to approve the income and expenses for March 2012 as presented. Rick Roach seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

ZONING ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE:

Gordon Ireland stated the Planning & Zoning Conference in Cave City is May 9th and the cost is \$65. Robert Enlow made a motion to approve the payment of \$65 for Gordon Ireland to attend the conference. Steve Payne seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Gordon Ireland compared the amount of building permits from last year and this year.

Gordon Ireland stated the City Council appointed two people to work on the sign ordinance. Janet Johnstone Crow from Nelson County has agreed to come to LaRue

County and talk about the sign ordinance in Nelson County. Steve Payne suggested he and Gordon Ireland meet Janet Johnstone Crow in Nelson County before asking her to meet in LaRue County.

Paul Lassankse asked about street lights being required in subdivisions. Gordon Ireland will call the electric companies.
